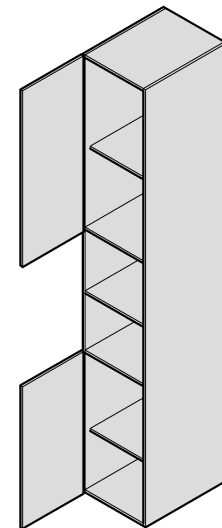
300 Wide Base Unit

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

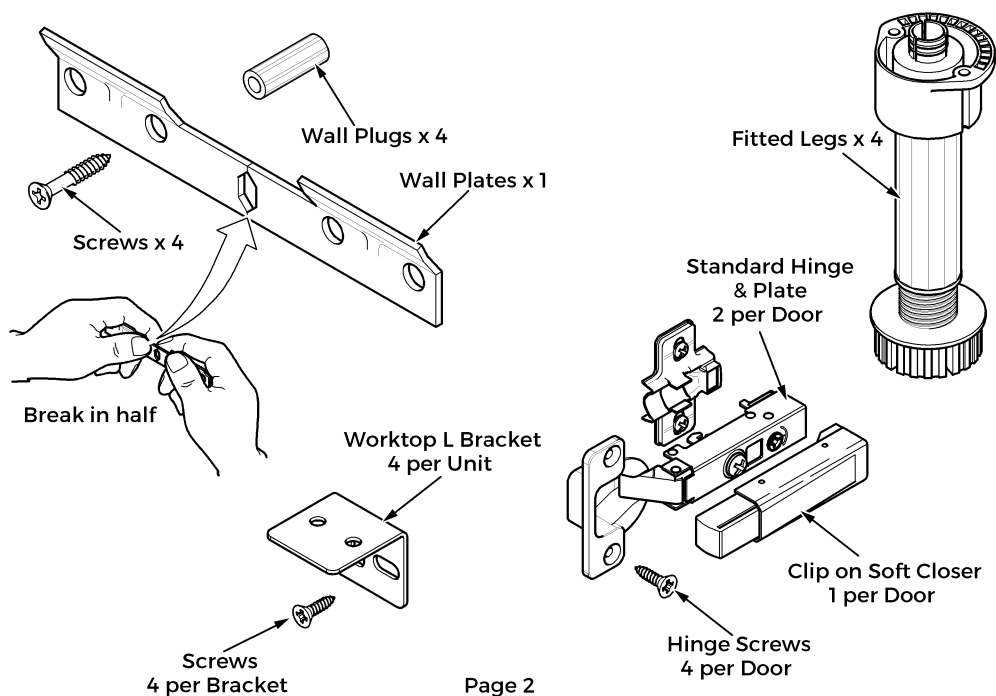
REMEMBER

- Handle product with care.
- When drilling walls, check first for hidden pipes and cables.
- Use safety eyewear when drilling.
- Keep all small parts away from children.
- If the product is over 20 kg (see packaging), 2 people are required to carry and install the unit.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Ensure all cut outs for plumbing are carried out prior to installation.
- All exposed edges of timber need to be treated or sealed using PVA.

Step 7 - Attaching the doors

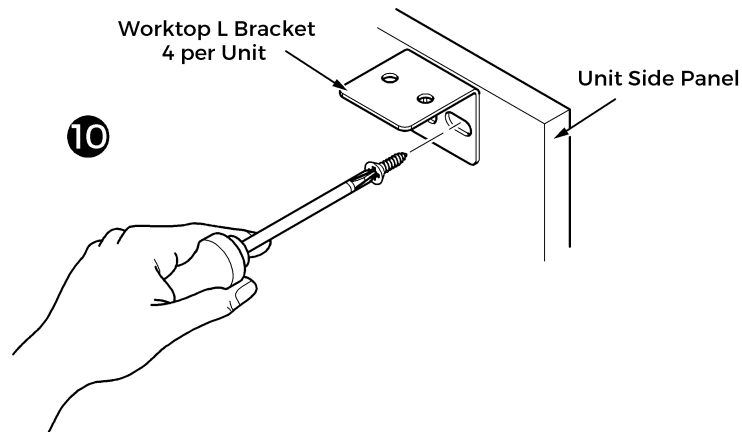

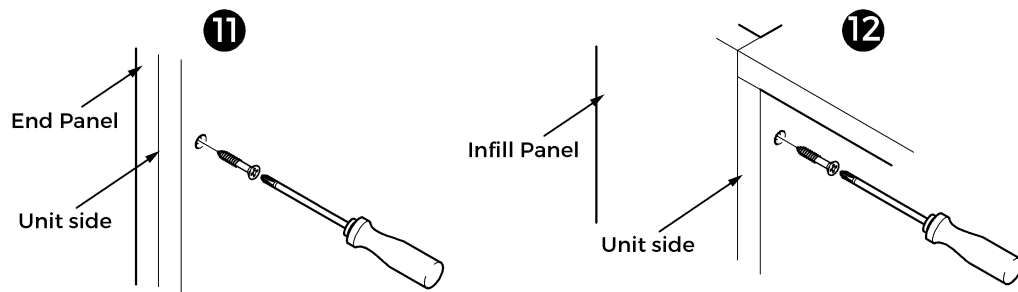
Step 5 - Fitting the Worktop

- Attach supplied worktop L Brackets (10).
- Once fitted follow instructions supplied with worktop to complete

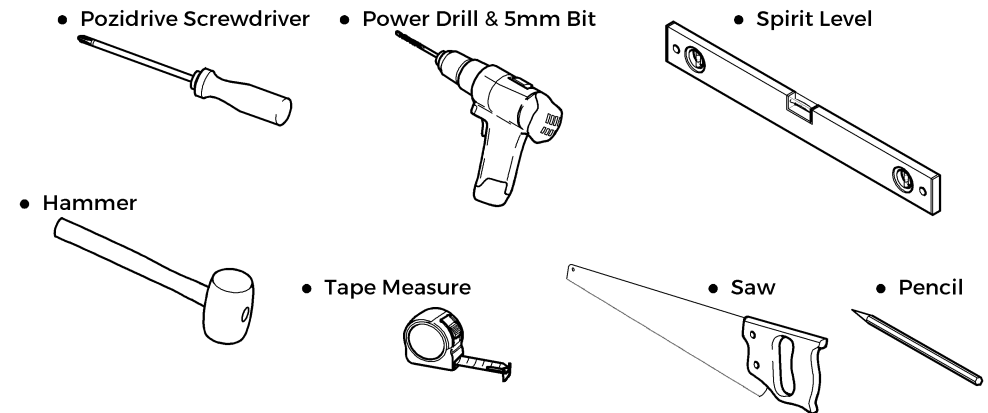


Step 6 - End panels /infill panels

- Not relevant to all Base, Wall & Tall units. Screws not supplied.
- End Panels: Cut end panel to required depth and height, then secure to unit side by screwing from inside the unit through to the panel. Ensure the screws are the correct length so as not to break through but are adequate to hold the panel in place (11).
- Infill Panels: Cut panel to the required width and height, then secure to unit side by screwing from inside the unit through to the panel, ensure the screws go in straight (12).

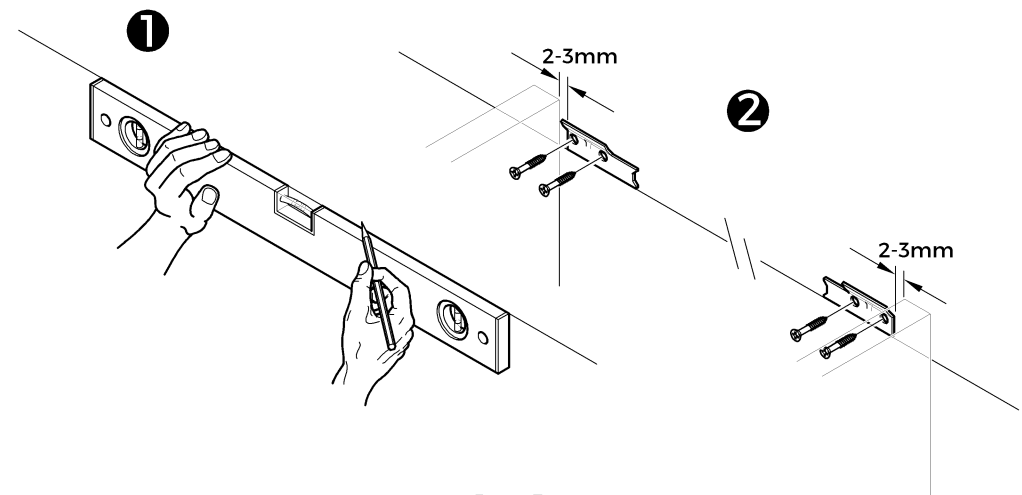

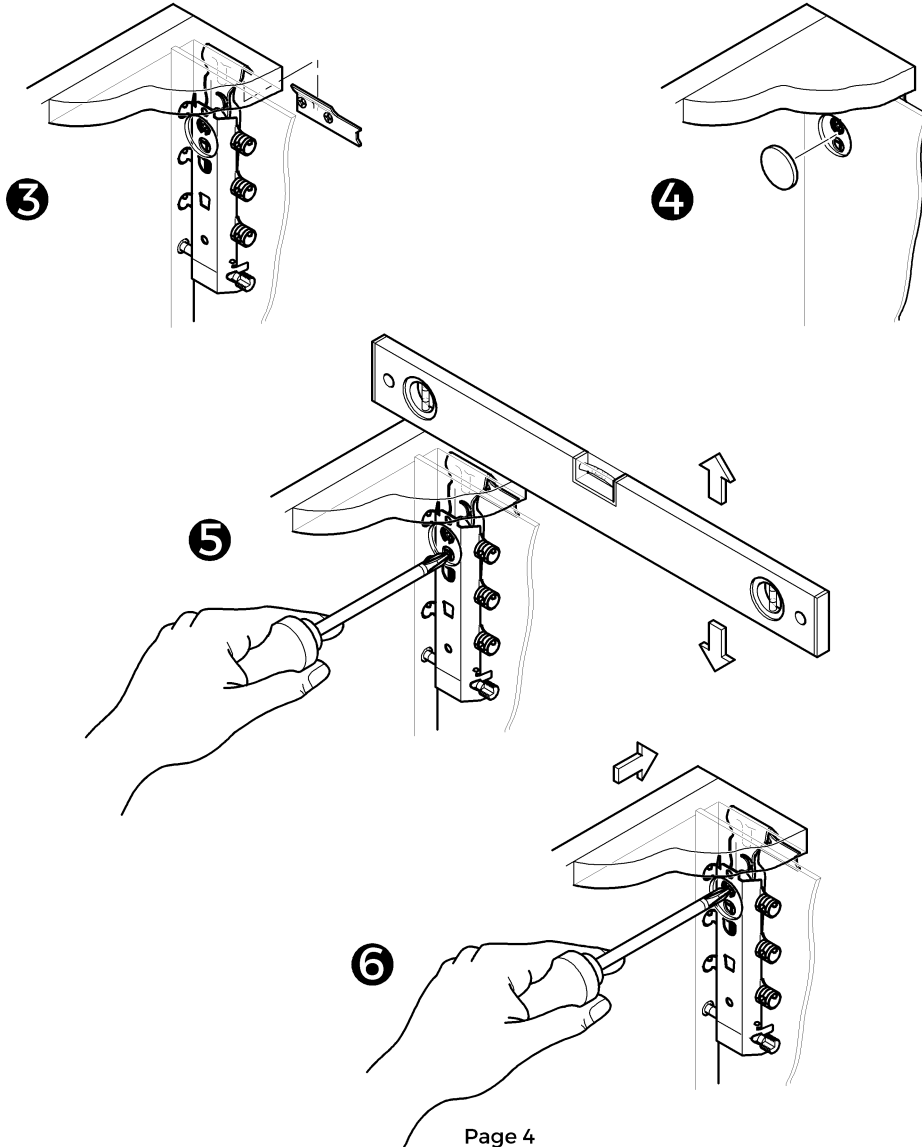
Step 1 - Wall Fixings

- Decide on the height of the Tall Unit and, using a spirit level, draw a horizontal line to work to (1).
- Mark out the internal dimensions of the unit making sure the plates are within the internal dimensions of the unit by 2-3 mm (2).
- Using a Power Drill along with the Wall Plugs and Screws provided, fix the plates in place.
- If the wall is not solid, you will need to use your own fixings. Ensure that they are adequate to support the total weight of the Unit as stated on the packaging.



Step 2 - Hang Unit

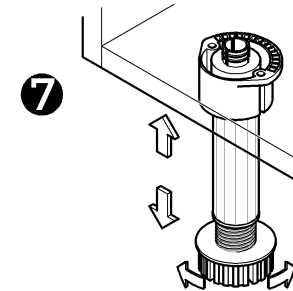
- Hang the unit on the Wall Mounting plates (3).
- Remove the Cover Caps. (4)
- Level the unit by adjusting the screw on the bottom of the Hanging Bracket. Use a spirit level (5).
- Once level, tighten the screw on the front of the Hanging Bracket to bring the Unit to the wall (6).



Note: Base Units stand on the floor so will come complete with fitted Legs (7).

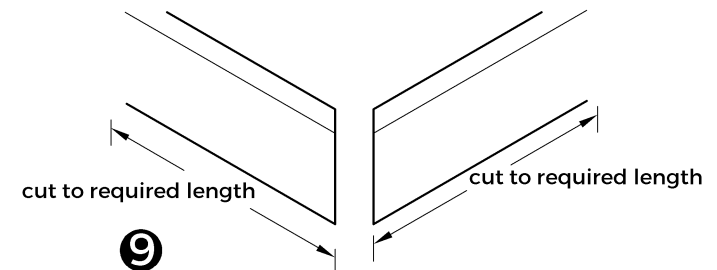
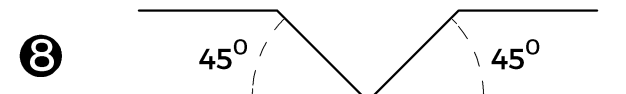
Step 3 - Adjusting the plinth

- To adjust the legs, turn to the left to increase the height or turn to the right to reduce the height. Check the legs are level and then fit the plinth using the clips provided (7).
- Please ensure legs are fitted as per orientation in image to avoid clashing with the plinth.



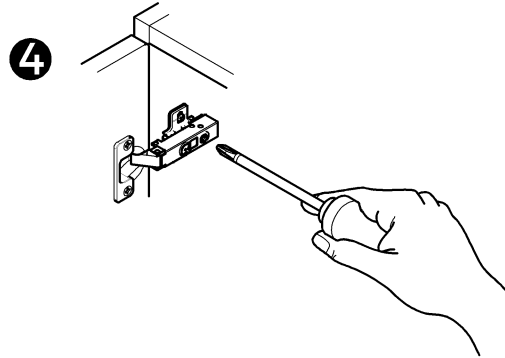
Step 4 - Mitring the plinth

- To turn the corner on the plinth mitre two pieces of Plinth to 45° (8).
- Then cut both to required length (9).



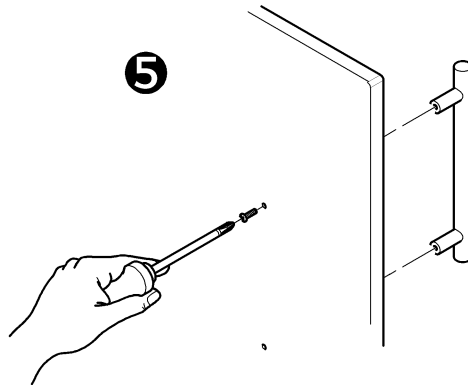
Step 4 - Adjust Hinge

- If the Door requires alteration, adjust screws on the Hinge to required level.



Step 5 - Fitting the Handle

- Attach Handle using Screws provided with Handle.

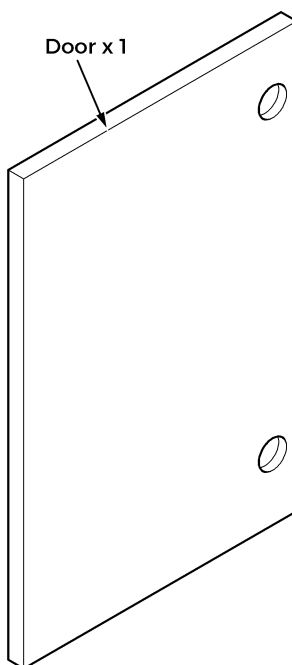

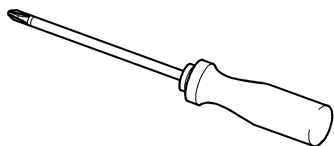

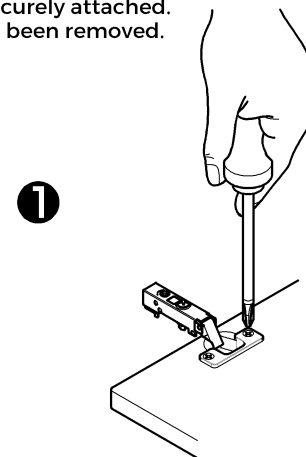
Tools Required (not supplied)

- Pozidrive Screwdriver



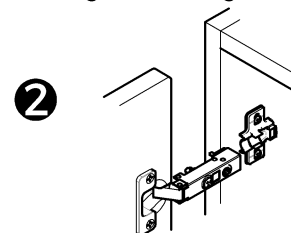
Step 1 - Secure Hinge

- Remove door from packaging and place on a flat surface.
- Ensure that the hinge is securely attached.
- Ensure the plastic film has been removed.



Step 2 - Position Door

- Position the door so that the Hinges align with the Hinge Plate on the Cabinet.
- Before attaching the Hinge to the Hinge Plate, press firmly on the end of the Hinge.



Step 3 - Attach Hinge

- Click Hinge into place on the Hinge Plate.
