
Step 2 - Hang Unit

- Hang the unit on the wall mounting plates (3).
- Level the unit using your spirit level and adjusting the screw on the bottom of the hanging bracket (4).
- Once level screw on the front of the hanging bracket to tighten the unit to the wall (5).

Note: Full height vanity units stand on the floor so will come complete with fitted legs. To adjust the legs, unclip the plinth from the legs and adjust the legs to the desired height (6). Replace the plinth.








Step 1 - Wall Fixings

- Decide on the height of the vanity unit and use a spirit level to draw a horizontal guideline (1).
- Mark out the internal dimensions of the unit making sure the plates are within the internal dimensions of the unit by 2-3 mm.
- Using a cordless drill along with the wall plugs and screws provided, fix the plates in place (2).
- If the wall is not solid, you will need to use your own fixings. Ensure that they are adequate to support the total weight of the unit as stated on the packaging.



Step 3- Fix Door to Cabinet and Adjust Hinges

- This illustration shows the door being fitted to the left side. Reverse for right-hand.
- · Screw the hinge and hinge plate assembly to the cabinet using a posidrive screwdriver.
- If the door requires alteration, adjust screws on the hinges.








Vanity Door Units with Integrated Handles Installation Instructions



Door on **right** side of 400mm cabinet. Hinges are fitted on the left side.



Door on **left** side of 400mm cabinet. Hinges are fitted on the right side.



600mm wide units with 2 doors








Step 1 - Fit Hinges


- Remove door from packaging and place on a flat surface.
- Fit the hinges to the door using a posidrive screwdriver.





Door on right side of cabinet. Hinges are fitted on the left side.




Door on left side of cabinet. Hinges are fitted on the right side.










Step 2- Position Door
